Protocol for Breastfeeding

- The Visitor requesting to breastfeed their child will notify a visiting room officer
- The visiting room officer will check to ensure that the room is available.
 - If the room is unoccupied, the officer will retrieve the keys to allow the visitor access into the room.
 - The window covering will be placed over the door window when the room is occupied.
 - The visitor may move the wall barrier to give themselves more privacy with their child.
 - When finished, the visitor will notify the officer.
 - The officer will search the room and secure the area.
 - If the room is occupied, the officer will inform the visitor that the room is not available presently and they will need to wait until it is vacated.
